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

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Proposed FY2022 Budget was submitted to HPLO. The working group session was attended by Asst AG Weinberg, Dr. Greg Miller, Dr. Richard Chong, Mamie Balajada, Sibyl Crisostomo, and the Treasurer, who completed the review, itemized each line item of the budget proposal covering all the object classes required. One object class total was calculated that was shared by all nine Boards. The other was calculated for specifically GBAHE, which was \$168,496.91. The amount will be changing as HPLO will be looking at correcting figures. From this amount, \$83,000-\$84,000 is calculated as the share for each of the nine boards and \$84,272.20 is calculated as the total for GBAHE. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Salaries: 1 Full-Time Investigator, 1 Full-Time Inspector (not included in GBAHE budget: HPLO performing the search) - Salary: 1 Full-Time Step I Administrative Assistant: \$48,538.20 - Off Island Travel: \$15,000.00 - Contractual: \$1,364.00 (for membership dues) - Drug Testing: \$120.00 (for new hire) - Miscellaneous: \$19,250.00 (for Board stipends, conference venues and training) - Total: \$84,000.00 (excludes investigator and inspector salary) - Note: There was an estimated total funds made based on current renewal fees, which is almost \$30,000 (9% of proposed budget). So, currently license fees alone cannot cover the budget.

VI.	<p>LEGAL COUNSEL REPORT <i>Robert Weinberg Assistant Attorney General</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Bill 102 signed into law P.L.36-34 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Live streaming of all Board and Commission meetings, so the public can observe what's going on in real time. If Board members will need to have access to a computer with audio and visual. HPLO is procuring new equipment, so Board members could participate in-person at the HPLO if necessary. The Law also requires that the Board and Commission publish agendas in advance of the meetings along with the Public Notices. The Boards will need to post an agenda that is specific enough so the Public is aware of the topics. There could also be a link to access more information, for example, a list for renewal applicants to be approved. B. Uniform Processes for Disciplinary Complaints <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Board needs to have a uniformed process when addressing and reporting disciplinary complaints, such as naming conventions for the minutes and agenda (e.g. case numbers, investigator or inspector or board member assigned). Disciplinary complaints are not subject to open government law. Asst AG Weinberg is looking into some naming convention that will report the case number assigned and investigator assigned for Public Documents and the identity of the complainant and licensee for Non-Public Documents. 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	<p>C. David Lubofsky Lawsuits</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Filed a lawsuit around June 15 against GBAHE and GBME. The essence is to compel the Boards to have Rules and Regulations that describe the process for investigating disciplinary complaints. David Lubofsky and Vanessa Williams have filed numerous FOIA requests which show Rules and Regulations; however, the format is currently not consistent with the Compiler of Laws. There have been rules for GBME since 2001 and GBAHE since 1984 and 1989 all describing general processes. Those attending current Board meetings will know that GBAHE has been working diligently since 2017 to update and modernize existing rules to make them more understandable to the layperson. Asst AG Weinberg sent a copy of this lawsuit to all Board Members for their reference. 			
<p>VII. GBAHE COMPLAINTS</p>	<p>A. GBAHE-CO-21-01</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Dr. Miller and Dr. Gregory brought to the Board's attention that there were some people advertising on social media that they were practicing massage, chiropractic, and acupuncture therapy without proper licensing. Asst AG Weinberg sent a Cease and Desist Letter and since then they have responded that they have a license from California and didn't think they needed one from Guam. Asst AG Weinberg set out the Guam Code in the Cease and Desist Letter. The Board has been advised that they have stopped. There hasn't been a follow up since then. <p>B. GBAHE-CO-20-11</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This is a complaint against a Podiatrist involving malpractice. GBAHE was able to find an unbiased Podiatrist from Arizona. GBAHE gathered all the case records and sent them to the Investigator who did an analysis. He said in his report that what he saw met the standard of care applicable to the situation. - Based on that. Asst AG Weinberg recommends dismissing this case. - Motion: Dr. Greg Miller, 2nd Catherine San Nicolas <p>C. GBAHE-CO-20-10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This is a complaint against a Respiratory Therapist that was involved/present in the hospital on the night that Asher Lubofsky was there and passed away. The issue is finding someone who can review the medical records from GMH, CMS (Medicaid/Medicare) reports to complete a full analysis. - Current Respiratory Therapists on the Board worked at GMH so they have a conflict with the case and cannot complete the analysis. - There was another name submitted to HPL0 two months ago who agreed to investigate. Since there is a price involved, there is a longer process for procurement of this investigator. The GSA requires two more quotes for a total of three quotes to obtain an investigator according to the Procurement Law. There was a proposed provision to obtain investigators under \$25,000 which involved sending out a statement of qualifications, they send resumes and the Board chooses. Then after that, the price is negotiated under \$25,000.
