	license to a school that is not accredited, i.e., an since an accreditation is a prerequisite			
_	to becoming a licensed school. Therefore, the GBBC needs to work with Asst AG R.			
	Weinberg in developing a resolution which would give the GBBC authority to license			
	a school in the interim while it is working toward its accreditation and while the
