

# Tritons start off strong in fall hoops

Fall basketball season began for the University of Guam Men's Basketball team as they played against the Dosidos in "Take It To The South 3" tournament hosted by the MicroFiends basketball club.

The Tritons defeated Dosidos 63-60 on Sunday at the Talo'fo'fo Community Center with the Tritons ready to take names, according to a release from UOG's Triton Athletics.

The team jumped out to a fast start and quickly led 15-2 behind the eight points scored early by Francis Borja, a freshman from John F.

Kennedy High School. After a Dosidos timeout, the Tritons returned and had their first lead at 18-17 with 12 minutes left in the first half, according to the release.

The Tritons didn't stop and took control again in the last few minutes of the first half and lead 38-29 at half-time.

Dosidos picked up the momentum during the second half, keeping it a close game. The Tritons held on to that lead for most of the final 20 minutes and with 50 seconds to go, it was tied 58-58, but Borja hit five-of-five free throws down the

stretch and the Tritons were able to hold on for a 63-60 win, according to the release.

Francis Borja led the Tritons with 22 points and Logan Hopkins added 10 points to the win. Former Triton Ryan Nangauta led Dosidos with 21 points, according to the release.
