22 - CARPENTER WITH 1 YEAR EXPERIENCE

\$15.58 PER HOUR*

Constructs, erects, installs and repairs structures and fixtures of wood, wallboard and plywood, including framework. Uses carpenter's hand tools and power tools conforming to local building codes. Reads blueprints, sketches, or building plans to determine type of work required and materials needed. Prepares layout, using ruler, framing square, and calipers. Erects framework for structure and lay subfloor board.

26 - CEMENT MASON WITH 1 YEAR EXPERIENCE

Smooths and finishes surfaces of poured concrete floors, walls, sidewalks, or curbs to specified textures using hand tools or power tools including floats, trowels, and screeds. Signals concrete deliverer to position truck to facilitate pouring concrete. Spreads concrete into inaccessible section of forms using rake or shovel. Levels concrete to specified depth and workable consistency using hand screed and floats to bring water to surface and produce soft topping. Lays concrete blocks and mixes cement using shovel or cement mixing machine.

Plans layout, installs and prepares wiring, electrical fixtures, apparatus and control equipment. Plans new or modified installations to minimize waste of materials. Prepares sketches concealing wiring and installs before completion of future walls, ceilings and floorings. Measures, cuts, bends, threads, assembles and installs electrical conduit using tools such as hacksaw, pipe threader, and conduit bender. Pulls wiring through conduit and splices wires by stripping installation from terminal loads with knife or pliers. Twist or solder wires together and apply tape or terminal caps. Connects wiring to lighting fixtures and power equipment using hand tools. Installs control and distribution apparatus such as switches, relays and circuit breaker panels fastening to place with screw or bolts using hand tools or power tools. Connects power of cable to equipment.
