	Z. Pecina expressed her satisfaction with Attorney Botha's presence, as the Board was dealing with a case involving individuals who were allegedly practicing chiropractic procedures without a license. She clarified that these individuals do not currently hold licenses, raising the question of whether the Board has jurisdiction over unlicensed practitioners. The Board had previously recommended referring the matter to the Attorney General to take necessary action to halt these activities. While the Board had issued a cease and desist order, the individuals continued their practice, leading to non-compliance with the Board's directive. Since the individuals are unlicensed, the Board has no authority to revoke a license, prompting the need for legal guidance on whether referring the case to the Attorney General was the appropriate course of action and what further steps should be taken. The discussion continued with a query about whether practicing without a valid license constitutes a criminal offense and, if so, whether it falls under the jurisdiction of the Attorney General's office for further action. S. Cristostomo added that while the professional license could not be revoked, the business license of the individuals involved could be. M. Balajadia then suggested that the Board should meet with Mr. Botha to seek his advice on how to proceed, particularly considering the background information they have on the matter. In response, Mr. Botha agreed that a meeting would be beneficial and inquired whether the Board had previously conducted an investigation into the company's activities to determine if they fell within the scope of chiropractic practices. M. Balajadia confirmed that a meeting with Mr. Botha would be arranged to discuss the details and next steps.
