He does a mobile practice throughout Guam, which is posted on-line. He has blocked access licensed practitioners on social media and is very difficult to track down. Very concerned of potential risk to patient safety, especially local citizens who have a particular condition and could be at high risk for paralysis if certain procedures are used. The Chair requested that this complaint be provided in written format and submitted to the GBAHE. Dr. Miller also expressed concern with the massage therapist performing manipulation therapy at spas and appears to be taking more liberties. In Guam, manipulation is not authorized for massage therapy, although it may be allowed in the eastern countries. He stated that some customers have been injured by those unlicensed to perform manipulation therapy. In reference to massage therapy, the Chair reported that KUAM news aired a segment about massage parlors and massage therapist, she discussed this issue with OAG, Governor's Office, and Speaker of the Legislature. To date, nothing has done to address this concern; however, it would be in the GBAHE's interest to resurrect this issue to address the licensing of massage therapists. Dr. Miller stated that there are two impediments in licensing of massage therapists: sexual base; exclusion of suruhānu.	G. Miller
