	examination, the Chair stated that this was a decision date determined by the Council, not the			
	GBAHE. Therefore, she recommends that EPPP2 be required to mitigate the situation and			
	concerns surrounding the effective date. She stated that the Board's decision to require the EPP2			
	or the implementation thereof was not a mistake of the GBAHE, but was done in good faith to			
	ensure the practitioners are competent to practice professional services. She stated that the			
	ASPPB requires the EPPP2 for states and territories, including Canada. In conclusion, the Chair			
	stated her position is that the EPPP2 examination would be required in Dr. Butler's case. In			
	response to the Chair's comments, Attorney Cook that his client has no disagreement with			

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	respect to the need to ensure competency. The letter provided by the Chair only informs the ASPPB that the GBAHE had adopted, however, at that time of notification, the Legislaure had not legally adopted this requirement by changing the law. It was only with the passing of P.L. 36-138 is the requirement for both exams now in effect. Furthermore, he stated that the website shows only three (3) states, Guam, D.C. and some Canadian provinces that have adopted the EPPP2 requirement. He stated that the Governor decided to let the bill since she felt the Legislature did not follow the AAA process for the Rules and Regulations, which should have been approved by the Governor for policy and the Attorney General for legal form; however, in this case the Legislature delegated power to the Board to update the Rules and Regulations. Although the Rules and Regulations are now in effect, he advised the Board to conduct a thorough review since the final document differs from the version submitted by the Board. # Jeffrey Springs agree to \$31M, 4-year contract

ST. PETERSBURG. Ha. (AP) - Lefthander Jeffrey Springs became the first of the 33 players who exchanged proposed arbitration with their teams to reach a deal, agreeing Wednesday to a \$31 million, fouryear contract with the Tampa Bay Rays that

could be worth \$65.75 million over five seasons.

The 30 year old Springs was among Rays who seven swapped arbstration figures with the team on Janii 13: He began last season in the bullpen, transitioned to the starting rotation in May and finished

.9-5 with a 2,46 ERA in 33 appearances, including 25 starts He is 14-6 with a 2.70 ERA in 76 outings 51 of them in relief since he was acquired from Baston in Feb ruary 2021.

Rays president of baseball operations Erik Neander said the sides had been work ing toward an agree ment for weeks and that Springs - draft ed in the 30th round by the Texas Rangers in 2015 - has earned the opportunity to be a big part of Tampa Bay's future.

"Jeffrey's journey in baseball is a story of constant development improvement. it's a heck of a story Neander said, noting Springs was not draft ed high and spent time with multiple organizations before
