Dr. Miller provided some examples of companies such as, Le Balance and Boka Box as well individuals in the community that might be seen as "practicing without a license." He suggested that GBAHE members be guided with standardized procedures when approaching businesses or individuals that maybe providing services without a valid license. He suggested that a protocol or guidelines be developed to help GBAHE board members interview or investigate complaints without jeopardizing due processes. He stated that he would review and determine if the HPLO policies on Complaint Handling and Discipline Process would be adequate. C. San Nicolas recommended that the GBAHE approach the issue with an aim to be helpful to the public and to avoid any liability. The Chair suggested that Dr. Miller's concerns be addressed and discussed in the Work Group, as she supports a public education campaign to help address these concerns. Dr. Miller stated that the DPHSS PIO could help address these suggestions through the media. She said that a Board member(s), when confronting a business establishment or individual suspected of providing services without a proper valid licensure issued by this Board, that another individual should be present as a possible witness, instead of approaching or arbitrary confronting them alone. record(s) earns the title. Even if the best team is three different teams.

### 1st championship

But because of reduced school days and COVID-19 restrictions, things were different this year. ISA Director for Middle Schools Caroline Cardines-Finch said the reduced school days left middle school basketball with not enough time to play a double-round-robin, meaning every team gets to play every other team twice.

Rather than award a third of a trophy, Cardines-Finch and her crew decided to let the teams earn one whole trophy.

"I'm getting goosebumps thinking about it. Having playoff games definitely created a different kind of energy in middle school sports," said Cardines-Finch. "Being able to say your school is part of the final four teams brought a lot of pride to the players and coaches."

### Proud coaches

Roadrunner coach Erwin Villa was happy to put his third of the championship trophy up for grabs.

"Oh man, I was so excited. With the playoffs, you're able to see who is really the top team because every year, whenever you have teams that are tied, you can't determine who's the champion. With these playoffs, you can. And the kids were really excited to have it."

Pirates coach Calvin Fejeran agreed. The Pirates advanced with a win over the Wildcats. The Roadrunners, seeded first based on total points scored, advanced with a win over the Astumbo Dragons. The Roadrunners beat the Pirates by a large margin during the regular season, but the Pirates were a different team Wednesday.

### Pirates

The Pirates led by as much as 11 points in the final minutes, but a 9-0 Roadrunners run over 43 seconds made it 38-36 with 40 seconds left in the game. It took four straight free throws by Phoenix Borja to put the game out of the Roadrunners' reach. The Pirates' Borja scored 19 and Darnell Camacho scored 10.

"Teamwork is what got us here, and teamwork is what helped us win this game," Fejeran said. "We practice free throws when they're tired, even when they don't want to. This is a great team that showed that hard work

pays off. All of their success is a credit to the team."

As for what's to come, Cardines said she'll be proposing a schedule similar to this year's for next season. There is no such news for her counterpart in the Independent Interscholastic Athletic Association of Guam, which runs sports for most private middle schools. They too are guided by history and co-champions.

"There's only one downside, she said — fewer games for teams overall."
