"That's actually become a good problem, so right now we're trying to find a way to let more students paddle," she said. And the paddlers aren't equally distributed either — schools such as Southern High and Simon Sanchez have small teams, while schools such as Father Dueñas, Academy of Our Lady, John F. Kennedy and Notre Dame have "mega teams," she added.

JFK, ND lead standings

In the first race on April 1 at Matapang Beach, the Notre Dame boys took top finishes in all three 500-meter races, earning the maximum 10 points for each race and a day total of 30 points in the varsity, or sotteru division.

The JFK and Okkodo High school boys teams are tied for second place with 24 points each. Okkodo might have had sole position of second place but a fifth-place finish in round 2 dropped them into a tie for second. JFK took third place in each race.

In the sottera, or girls var-

sity division, the Lady Islanders took first place in all three rounds, and the Notre Dame Royals took second in all three rounds also, finishing less than two seconds behind JFK in the final round. The Cougars had a third, a fifth and a fourth-place finish to earn 21 points, edging the Panthers which had a fifth place and two fourth place finishes.

In the sotteru mix, or mixed varsity division, the Islanders swept all three races with blazing times. The Guam High team went from a sixth place finish in the first round to a third and second place finish over the next two races. They sit in second place along with ND's mixed team, which had a fifth, a second and a fourth place finish. The FD/Academy team sits behind in fourth place.

This Saturday's race will be a two-mile race. Varsity teams will paddle a half-mile out and back for one lap, and do two laps for one round. There will be two rounds, Murphy said.

Races return to Matapang Beach for the April 15 and April 29 events.

plowed through the defense throughout the first quarter and finished with 154 yards rushing and two touchdowns.

Parker accounted for 186 total yards and both TD passes were to Delia, who scored on a 35-yarder and 50-yard catch and run.

At Mangilao, the Geckos broke open a close game in the second half. After putting up the first touchdown as time expired in the first quarter, the Titans struck back when quarterback Chris Angoco hit Ryen Cruz for a TD strike and a 6-6 tie.

GW found paydirt again at the end of the first half to take a 12-6 lead into the break.

The Geckos offensive line continued to create huge holes, giving the Gecko backs plenty of clearance at the line of scrimmage. The Geckos finished the contest with a 31-6 score over the Titans.

Albert "Pebbles" Rokop, the right offensive tackle, said the Geckos front five communicated on every play and covered each other with teamwork. He said it was Brian Hayes, Anthony Charfauros at center, Donovan Reyes at left guard and James Sakati at left tackle.

"We spoke during the huddle, we knew what we needed to fix," he said. "We were proud of all of our running backs today."
