San Nicolas presented an addendum to the treasurer's report, which detailed fees collected from August to December, with a focus on October, November, and December. She highlighted several discrepancies in the renewal rates for various professions, including PAs, podiatrists, marriage family therapists, licensed mental health counselors, licensed professional counselors, collective practice agreements, physical therapist and SLPAs. These inconsistencies included incorrect payments for renewal fees and differences in the reported amounts. C. San Nicolas suggested the need for better consistency in how data is entered into the report, pointing out that the October report was clean, but the November and December entries were disorganized. Additionally, she emphasized that there were missing records for September and requested that the renewal data be itemized more accurately to ensure reliable reporting. It was clarified that January and February would be given to R. Taitingfong.</p> <p>Dr. Kim pointed out that there was an issue with the podiatry fee schedule, as no podiatry fees were listed, causing confusion. It was clarified that the discrepancy likely occurred when a payment was made for a podiatrist through the medical license renewal process, where the fee was listed as \$250 instead of the expected amount of \$80. B. Sablan speculated that the payment might have been made for both the podiatrist's and their spouse's licenses, but it was acknowledged that the confusion arose from the way the payment was processed online.</p> <p>C. San Nicolas mentioned that she would not be investigating the discrepancies further, but wanted to highlight the issues with the data. She explained that sometimes the documents did not specify the discipline, making it difficult for her to extract and provide accurate information. This was particularly true for online payments, where the discipline was often not indicated.</p> <p>Dr. Balajadia clarified that PAs and podiatrists do not follow the new fee schedule, as they are not part of the new law. Instead, they are still operating under the old fee schedule, which explains the discrepancies in their payment amounts. C. San Nicolas pointed out that PAs had two different renewal fees, one at \$80 and another at \$130, which requires further investigation to rectify. Dr. Balajadia emphasized the need to address and study this issue soon.</p> <p>Dr. Harper shared her experience in December when she visited the Treasurer of Guam twice to make a payment for three licenses, totaling \$700. She encountered confusion at the facility as they struggled to process the payment, which led to multiple trips. Her concern was that if she, as a board member, faced such difficulties, other individuals might also experience similar issues. She emphasized the importance of tracking and addressing these challenges to improve the payment process.</p> <p>Dr. Balajadia further explained that when she made her payment, the Treasurer of Guam did not have the account number for HPLO, so they had to look it up. After her visit, the account number for HPLO for Guam Board of Allied Health was then indicated on the payment receipt at the bottom of the payment form. 	<p>B. Sablan clarified that a new fiscal and accounting system was implemented last year, with new accounts assigned to all boards. However, it appears that the Treasurer of Guam is still using the old system, which led to confusion and required the use of the old account numbers. She assured the board that discrepancies in payment amounts occur due to various additional fees, such as license verification, being added to the renewal fee. She also explained that an audit is currently being conducted by DOA, and once completed, she would be able to provide more detailed information. However, it was noted that the old system, AS-400, did not track these additional fees, so it would require manual work to extract this data from each applicant's records.</p> <p>Dr. Harper emphasized the importance of itemizing payments accurately, drawing a parallel to adding an extra item to an order, to ensure transparency and proper monitoring of finances. B. Sablan acknowledged the concern and assured the board that while the process took time, she and J. Bruan would work on providing a detailed report for the next board meeting.</p>			
V	<p>Administrator's Report</p> <p>B. Sablan shared two updates. First, she plans to collaborate with all boards to create educational content, specifically focusing on frequently asked questions (FAQs) that can be shared with the public. The idea is to pre-record sessions in the conference room and then hold live sessions with various media outlets. She encouraged brainstorming with the board members to identify relevant questions and topics for these educational initiatives.</p> <p>Secondly, the board was informed that she is in the process of planning the annual board orientation, which is tentatively scheduled for August 2025. She hopes to secure a purchase order before the end of the fiscal year and will provide further details as they become available.</p>	B. Sablan	1224	Noted

Pereda expressed concern over the prolonged duration of the case and suggested dismissing it since no progress had been made. However, Dr. Balajadia and B. Sablan pointed out that the board has been deferring the case while waiting for legal counsel, which has been delayed due to issues with securing an attorney and purchase orders for the new year. They emphasized the importance of getting legal guidance before dismissing the case, as there are valid concerns to address. They acknowledged the challenges in getting legal input from the Attorney General and stated that they would continue working on this matter to resolve it.</p> <p>B. GBAHE-CO-23-02 Veterinarian Received 12/28/23</p> <p>Dr. Harper expressed concerns about the complaints not being handled properly due to a lack of legal advice and suggested that the situation might be similar to the previous case, where the necessary timelines and procedures were not followed. B. Sablan clarified that the board is still waiting on the procurement of an off-island consultant for the case. Unfortunately, they were unable to proceed with the small purchase procurement process. Instead, they had to go through a RFP, which delayed progress in the case. Both Dr. Harper and B. Sablan acknowledged that the situation would not progress quickly and agreed to continue working together to review the complaints once the consultant is secured. VII	Old Business	A. Late Renewal Applications 1. Roa, Jessie C. for Physical Therapy. R. Taitingfong noted that J. Roa has not renewed his license since 2020, and as a result, cannot practice. The practice address listed was at the SDA clinic, but since the license expired, he cannot be employed without renewing it. When Dr. Balajadia contacted the HR office, which confirmed that he is not currently employed but is seeking part-time work. However, to proceed, he must renew his license. The concern also arose from his application, which was received in December 2024, as the renewal window had passed. According to the fee schedule, it had been more than three years, so it should be treated as an initial application, not a renewal. J. Bruan will email the individual to inform them that the application needs to be considered as an initial one due to the delay. Additionally, he cannot list a practice address where he is not currently working, as that would cause issues for the SDA physical therapy clinic if the person were practicing without a valid license. He did provide a transcript indicating that he completed the courses, but the transcript lacked any identifiers linking it to the certificates. C. San Nicolas mentioned that she requires an identifier or additional information to confirm the validity of the certificates.
