Pereda let loose a string of tough jump-float serves, and the Friars responded by gifting ND error after error until the set comeback was complete, 26-24.

ND carried that energy into the third. Masato Rabago and Pereda continued to tally kills, and T'Shon Palomo and Tim Gumataotao found their timing with setter Isaac Limtiaco. For several minutes it was like two giants taking turns beating each other, as Mafnas never let up in the middle. All hitters went full auto as they padded the damage report with confirmed kills. Rabago caught fire late in the set and pounded three monster shots as the Royals sprinted at the end to win 25-21.

FD backup setters Reo Okawa and Yoshi Sayama subbed in to give Balajadia a breather, and both did well. Balajadia responded in the fourth by turning less-than-perfect passes into guided missiles for his hitters and they responded, especially the 15-year-old sophomore.

"We just played our game," Del Carmen said. "Good defense, good sets, good hit, that's it. I just wanted to play my game and we came through."

FD asserted itself and tied the match with a 25-15 win, then took a 9-5 lead in the fifth. ND roared back and leapfrogged the Friars, going up 10-9 before the mercurial meltdown.

"I think we did very good, way better than the

last game," said Rabago, referring to a 3-1 loss to the St. John's Knights. "We were doing well, but after a couple of missed shots, we couldn't get out of that rut."

Rabago said his team needs to work on their fire and celebrate not just the monster blocks and kills, but even the lucky tips and tools. The Royals are a team, he said, and will only improve in unison.

"It was our errors. I could have set a couple balls higher when I was running the quicks," said setter Limtiaco, a senior. "We still did way better than last game so it's just a matter of bettering those plays next time around"
