Masters black absolute winner JJ Ambrose of Machado defeated Erik Flores of Heights Academy. Ambrose was up 2-0 with 51 seconds left when he got Flores to submit.

Female

Female jiuJitsu players also showed up in record numbers. Tanya Muna of Heights Academy defeated teammate Trina Dueñas 9-0 on points to take the masters female absolute trophy, while Alliance Guam's Eunice Castro

finished third. Purebred's Francesca Lizama defeated teammate Nina Roberto on points to win the purple absolute division.

Atos teammates Emma Taitano and Shadriana Flores met in the finals of the female blue absolute, with Taitano taking the win by decision following a scoreless tie in regulation. Mikenna Carbullido took gold in the white belt absolute.

Fury promoter Steve Shimizu said that he was blown away by the event.

"People are loving it, great, great fights and competition and it shows. Everybody is just having

a blast and competition is nonstop," he said. "It was great sportsmanship displayed by the kids. It really did bring the island together. It really shows a higher level. Even though the coaches want their team to win, they have so much respect, and the kids see it. Hats off to the coaches, phenomenal job on the kids. If I were to choose which of them would win, I couldn't. But ... there is a winner."

Atos Jiu-Jitsu Guam won the coveted Best Team Kids trophy, just eight points ahead of Heights Academy Guam with 78 points, Heights Academy had 75

points after all points were totaled for podium finishes.

Atos Jiu-Jitsu, in its first entry into the Marianas Open, ran away with the Best Team Adults trophy with 90 points, well ahead of Carlson Gracie and Purebred, which tied for second place with 67 points. The Atos adults maintained a winning percentage with 26 wins over 21 losses.

Even the adult team battle for fourth was tight, with Heights earning 53 points, just enough to push Machado Guam to fifth with 52 points.

Shimizu said that he was surprised with Atos as they've only been active

for seven months. "Seeing a brand new team, such as Atos...that blew me away," said Shimizu. "They were there...it shows that jiuJitsu is definitely growing."

celebrated quickly and went back to work.

Pangelinan said his squad bought into and executed, what he calls the long game. Rather than try to put away the game at every opportunity, Pangelinan convinced them that they were built to withstand a siege.

"Play long rallies. Understand that Wes is gonna get his kills. But we have to defend the rest. To try and outlast them," said Pangelinan. "Wes Keith ... man. that guy ... — he's a machine. So, we're kinda lucky that he's only front row for three rotations, right? And we take care of the rest. Play long rallies. Don't worry about the momentum shift. Just keep going, keep going."

In each of the three sets, setter Connor Balajadia found the wave and took his team for a ride. He had already established the middle with Joe Mafnas,

who could whip the ball but didn't have to every time. Balajadia fed the ever-reliable Ethan Alvarez, who sat out some of the semifinal game. Balajadia welcomed outside hitter Gabriel Sarmiento back to beast mode, throwing him a couple of early sets to see if he had shaken off the funk that led to a sub-par performance last week, and time on the bench. It was tough to see the guy who cheers the loudest and longest on the bench, said Pangelinan, but everyone hits a slump sooner or later.

"He's our hype man. He's one of the guys who brings the energy. Even when he wasn't playing well, he was on the side, full of energy still. And everybody's entitled to have that one off-game. So he had it — lucky it wasn't in the final — and as soon as he got that first kill, we just let him go, let him do his thing."

Sarmiento admitted that his nerves took him out of his last game. On Saturday, he came to grips with them.

"I just had to breathe,

to breathe. And tell myself that everything will be OK," said the burly outside hitter. "And it was. It was OK."

Balajadia had distributed the ball masterfully, like a conductor, inviting his hitters to float in the air and finish the point. He worked Mafnas and Kiko Damian in the middle until the Eagles had to counter with two, sometimes three blockers. Harvest was up 19-17 in the third set as Keith made it rain. Then Balajadia turned the hype man into the hitman. Boom, boom, and Sarmiento got louder and even seemed to jump higher.

A bad Harvest pass drifted too close to the net, and Sarmiento pounced on it, denting the floor to put FD up 22-20, but with that, the game was already over. A couple of errors later, the Friar fans rushed the floor, many of them holding up four fingers on each hand.

The long game worked. The siege was repelled. And within the Friar walls, celebration.

In the night's only other game, the Notre Dame Royals finished in third place with a 3-1 win over the Saint Paul Christian School Warriors.
