

# Celtics' Hardy takes Jazz coaching gig

As the Utah Jazz spent time talking to candidates to become their next coach, Will Hardy quickly rose to the top of their list. And that's where he stayed.

Hardy was announced as the coach of the Jazz on Wednesday, a day after the sides came to an agreement in principle. He'll be a head coach in the NBA for the first time and, at 34, is currently the league's youngest coach.

"As our search committee went through this process, Will really separated himself among a group of extremely talented candidates," Jazz general manager Justin Zanik said. "We're eager to get to work with him as we continue our pursuit of bringing an NBA championship to Utah."

Hardy goes to Utah after spending this past season as an assistant in Boston, helping the Celtics make the NBA Finals. His previ-

ous 11 seasons were spent with the San Antonio Spurs, starting as a basketball operations intern, moving into the video room and eventually becoming an assistant under all-time wins leader and five-time NBA champion Gregg Popovich.

"The Utah Jazz are one of the most respected and successful franchises in the NBA and the fan base here is legendary," Hardy said. "This opportunity comes with tremendous responsibility. I'm grateful for the trust the Jazz have placed in me and I look forward to the work ahead."

Also Wednesday, the Jazz announced the hiring of longtime NBA coach David Fizdale as an associate general manager. Fizdale has been a head coach in New York and Memphis, plus an assistant for the Los Angeles Lakers, Miami, Golden State and Atlanta.

Hardy will replace Quin Snyder, who decided to

leave the Jazz earlier this month after eight seasons.

Snyder and the Jazz made the playoffs in each of the

last six seasons — tied for the second-longest current streak of postseason appearances in the league — and Hardy takes over a roster that features an All-Star-level guard in Donovan Mitchell and perennial defensive player of the year candidate Rudy Gobert.

## From the court to the stage: Stephen Curry to host ESPYS

LOS ANGELES (AP) — Fresh off helping the Golden State Warriors win the NBA championship, Stephen Curry will host 'The ESPYS.

The show, which honors the past year's top athletes and moments in sports, airs live on ABC on July 20 from Los Angeles.

Curry, who was named the Finals MVP, is nominated for three awards, including best male athlete.

"I've had the pleasure of attending The ESPYS but never imagined I'd have the privilege of hosting this special event," Curry said in a statement.

Off the court, Curry co-founded a multimedia company that focuses on

diverse content involving family, sports and faith. Unanimous Media executive produces ABC's sports reality show "Holey Moley." Curry's cofounder, Erick Peyton, will serve as a co-executive producer of The ESPYS.

The ESPYS will honor Vitali Klitschko, former heavyweight boxing champion and mayor of Kyiv, Ukraine, with the Arthur Ashe Courage Award. Retired Army Command Sgt. Maj. Gretchen Evans will receive the Pat Tillman Award for Service.

Hall of Fame college basketball broadcaster Dick Vitale will receive the Jimmy V Award for Perseverance.

# Women's Alpha, men's Echo win 3X3 tourney

Women's Alpha and men's Echo teams won the Fédération Internationale du Sport Universitaire Oceania Organization's 3X3 Basketball tournament Tuesday at the University of Guam Calvo Field House.

The tournament primarily had UOG students compete in men's and women's divisions, according to a release from Triton Athletics. The men's four teams were Echo, Alpha, Bravo and Delta. The women's division teams were Alpha, Bravo and Delta.

Team Alpha came out victorious in the women's division after defeating Delta at 5-3 in the opener and later dropping Bravo 14-8 in a round robin play, according to the release.

Alpha included players Katrina Santos, Nicole Pineda and Alaunah Merto. They claimed the first seed and a bye into the gold medal game.

The gold medal game was filmed and FISU Oceania will review Alpha's performance and the team may be picked to represent FISU Oceania in the FISU World 3X3 Cup in October and November in Turkey, according to the release.

Team Echo also came out undefeated in the men's division. The team consisted of Matt Santos, Darryl Robles, Tristan Valdes and

During the semifinals, Echo defeated Bravo 21-6 and remained undefeated going into the gold medal game. Echo defeated Delta 21-17 with Delta taking silver and Alpha taking bronze, according to the release.

The men's gold medal game was recorded and Echo could be picked to represent FISU Oceania in the FISU World 3X3 Cup as well.

The men's and women's winners will compete against New Zealand, Australia and other Oceania countries, who held 3X3 competitions for their college students. The winner will be announced by the

end of July, according to the release.
