The University of Guam Lady Tritons suffered another loss, this time to Fuetsa by BioSteel, during the Lady Triton – Global Learning Super League Monday night at the UOG Calvo Field House.

The team lost the close game at 63-61, while the Lady Bombers defeated Team MIBBC 106-35, keeping the No. 1 seed, according to a release from UOG’s Triton Athletics.

The game between the Lady Tritons and Fuetsa was close from the start with Fuetsa taking the lead 13-12 after the first quarter. The Tritons were able to pass Fuetsa by the second quarter at 16-15, but Fuetsa took the lead back by halftime, according to the release.

The Tritons tried to pull through in start of the second half with their best offense scoring 23 points in the 10-minute period,
