the go-ahead goal to break a 1-1 tie, and in about six minutes, the Cougars' semifinal upset of the Panthers would be complete.

Panther forward Nykale Penn found a way to change that outlook. With the Cougars in prevent mode, a well-placed through ball found its way toward the Academy goal. Keeper Natasha Kelly sprinted forward to intercept, Penn dribbled past her at the 18 and the ball slowly rolled to the back of an empty net. A minute later, time expired with the score knotted at 2-2.

Academy had spent almost all of the first half playing from behind. Aubrey Ibanez got a cross from Penn just five minutes into the match and scored.

The Cougars Hinengi San Nicolas answered 15 minutes later, taking a cross from Paulino and beating the keeper.

It wasn't until the 72nd minute when Paulino scored to break the tie, before Penn sent the game into overtime in the 85th minute.

The teams went into overtime mode and each team had opportunities to score but both goalkeepers stopped any game-winning shots. When overtime time expired, it came down to a penalty shootout, where each team chooses five players to shoot, best score wins.

Both teams made their first goals but Kelly got a hand on the Panthers' second shot for a short-lived advantage. Then Velazquez had a block, and the Panthers scored to even the game. But Velazquez wasn't done. She blocked the next

two that came her way while a teammate hit the necessary strike to win.

"I was pretty nervous 'cause I've done penalty kicks before," she said. "But at the end I got my confidence."
