	C. CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP – R. WEINSTEIN INC. (NR-PHW089) TO HENRY SCHEIN, INC. A. Mariano mentioned that the applicant has a pending registration with the Government of Guam but does not yet have an inspection report or license from the state of Hawaii. The inspection for Hawaii was scheduled to take place soon, and the license would be issued when the transaction closes on March 3rd. Once the transaction closes, the new license will be provided. C. Guthrie, representing the company, confirmed that the inspection was happening soon and that the transaction was planned to close on March 3rd. It was noted that the current license for R. Weinstein to Henry Schein, pending the receipt of the state license and inspection report. <i>Motion to Conditionally Approve: A. Mariano; 2nd: A. Eustaquio</i></p> <p>D. Diagnostic Laboratory Services Inquiry The board discussed an inquiry from Diagnostic Laboratory Services regarding guidance on handling laboratory orders for temporary patients, such as visitors requiring lab work while on vacation. The conversation addressed whether mainland primary care providers could issue lab requests without local offline medical records. It was noted that for one-time occurrences, the current practice is for the medical director, often a physician, to write the order for the patient, which has not been an issue. The discussion also touched on the absence of a laboratory licensing board and how regulatory responsibilities might be allocated among existing medical, nursing, allied health, and pharmacy boards. Early discussions within the medical and nursing boards indicated no immediate concerns, but there was an interest in ensuring protections for laboratories if such cases became more frequent. It was mentioned that regulations vary by state, and the medical board chair, Dr. Berg, intended to bring the matter to the board's attention. The intent was to initiate discussions on drafting appropriate rules and guidelines, potentially expanding to include prescriptions in the future.</p> <p>E. BIONIX LLC Inquiry The board discussed an inquiry from BIONIX LLC regarding whether a license is required for manufacturing and distributing a sterile medical device. Since the company does not have a manufacturing facility in the state, it was clarified that they would need to apply for licensure in their home state. If they intend to distribute their products outside their home state, they must apply for a non-residential license. It was noted that not all states require a manufacturing license if the company itself is not engaged in manufacturing within that state. The discussion also raised the question of whether the device in question requires a prescription and whether it falls under federal regulation for prescriber-only use. It was determined that the device is classified as a Class I medical device, which carries minimal risk and requires limited regulatory oversight. The board suggested that BIONIX LLC proceed with applying for a non-residential license and ensure compliance with applicable regulations.</p> <p>F. Accepting applications without Foreign Pharmacy Graduate Examination Committee Certification The board discussed whether applications could be accepted without Foreign Pharmacy Graduate Examination Committee (FPGEC) certification. It was noted that to take the NAPLEX and MPJE exams, applicants must first obtain certification and then apply for licensure by examination. The primary concern was whether the applicant was seeking licensure as an intern or through reciprocity. If applying for reciprocity, it was assumed that the applicant had already been licensed in one of the 50 U.S. states, which would indicate that they had met the initial requirements for licensure. The Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) will receive sealed proposals for IFB GHURA-25-007 Renovation of 8 Public Housing Units at AMP2 & AMP3, until 2:00 p.m., ChST, on Wednesday, April 9, 2025, at GHURA's Main office in Sinajana.

Interested parties must register at GHURA's Main Office in Sinajana to receive access to a downloadable bid packet file and receive notifications of any changes, amendments and/or addendums; or to obtain a physical copy of the bid packet; there is a fee of \$50.00 (exact cash amount, money order, or company check) which is non-refundable. Registration schedule is: Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. ChST with the exception of Government of Guam holidays. Pre-bid conference will be held on Friday, March 14, 2025, at 2:00 p.m., ChST in the GHURA main office conference room in Sinajana. A site visit will be conducted by GHURA staff on Tuesday, March 18, 2025, at 9:00 a.m., (see GHURA's website for site map). Attendance at pre-bid conference or site visit is nonmandatory, but highly recommended. Any questions regarding the project or requirements must be submitted in writing via email to Antonio C. Camacho, Housing Procurement Administrator, at proc@ghura.org no later than Friday, March 28, 2025. Bid closing date and time is Wednesday, April 9, 2025, at 2:00 p.m. ChST. All bid submittals will be opened publicly at GHURA's main office conference room, Sinajana.

Pursuant to 5 GCA Chapter 5 § 5212, bid guarantees in the amount of 15% of the total base bid shall accompany each bid. Bid guarantee shall be a bid bond secured by a surety company authorized to do business in Guam and listed in the latest Department of Treasury Circular 570 published in the Federal Register or as permitted by state law, a certified check, bank draft, or U.S. Government Bond at par value. All bid guarantees must be made payable to GHURA. Personal checks will not be accepted. GHURA reserves the right to waive irregularities and to reject any or all bids, whole or in part, in the best interest of the Territory of Guam, as provided for in 2 GAR Div. 4 § 3115(e)(2). In addition, GHURA also has the right to cancel all bids as provided in 5 GCA § 5225 and 2 GAR Div. 4 § 3115(c).

For all contracts which exceed \$100,000.00, the successful bidder will be required to furnish and pay for a performance and payment bond for 100% of the contract price. GHURA will retain the bid guarantee until the performance bond is received and will release it soon thereafter. The contractor must not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, disability, or genetic information in employment or the provision of services. There is a restriction against contractors employing convicted sex offenders from working at Government of Guam venues. (5 GCA § 5253).

The successful bidder will be required to accomplish the following to the best possible and greatest extent feasible:

1. A goal of awarding at least 50 % of the dollar value of construction contracts to Minority and/or Women Business Enterprises (MBE/WBE) or general contractors with MBE/WBE participation.
2. In accordance with Section 3 of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968, all construction contractors, to the maximum extent feasible shall provide training, contracting, and employment opportunities to low-income residents residing in GHURA public housing.

GHURA intends to award a contract on the basis of the lowest most responsive and responsible bid for the work described in the bid documents. No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 60 days subsequent to the opening of bids without the prior written consent of GHURA.
