Guam's 5-year Consolidated Plan 2025-2029 and Annual Action Plan 2025  
For the use of Community Planning and Development Funds (CPD) from the  
U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)

The Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA), the administrator of various HUD-funded programs for the Government of Guam, is preparing a combined 5-year strategic plan, the Consolidated Plan, and a first-year action plan, the Annual Action Plan 2025 for the use of HUD CPD funds.

For the Consolidated Plan, Guam residents are encouraged to participate in Public Hearings to share their input on community needs, priorities, or potential projects or activities to address those needs, as defined and funded by HUD for the various programs. This includes Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and Housing Trust Fund (HTF) funds for Guam's next Consolidated Plan of Program Year 2025-2029 (October, 01, 2025 – September 30, 2030).

Public Hearings allow GHURA to engage the public and community stakeholders and are designed to aide GHURA to identify the needs of the community and to establish priorities for federally funded activities.

GHURA intends to adjust award amounts to align with actual available funding levels once known. Estimates are as follows:
