	E. ERRAND GUAM	-		Noted
	The discussion centered on ERRAND GUAM and the appropriate procedures for pharmacies using this delivery service. Although there is no specific law governing such services, it was proposed to survey licensed pharmacies to determine if they use ERRAND GUAM and to ensure they submit their procedures to the Board for best practices. Emphasis was placed on maintaining compliance, addressing medication loss, and ensuring patient safety. M. Gabriel highlighted the necessity of knowing if ERRAND GUAM was classified as a pharmacy or a delivery service and whether third-party involvement was necessary.			
	The discussion noted the importance of bonding and insurance for such services and reiterated the responsibility of local pharmacies to ensure proper medication dispensing. Despite no final decision from the previous year due to jurisdictional limits, it was agreed that any local pharmacy using the service must adhere to Board rules and regulations. The importance of providing patient counseling, even though delivery services, was underscored, and the need to ensure patients receive proper information and have access to counseling was stressed.			
	J. Caruso suggested that the Board might not have jurisdiction over ERRAND GUAM, as no specific regulations exist for such delivery services. The Board should consult pharmacies to see if they use
