The Guam Waterworks Authority invites sealed bids for Galvanized Pipes under GWA IFB NO. 2024-02. Bids will be accepted until 10:00 a.m. Chamorro Standard Time on May 29, 2024, at the GWA Procurement Office, situated on the first floor of the Gloria B. Nelson Public Services Building in Mangilao. At this appointed time and location, all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.
