Mina Manibusan said she actually felt more pressure to perform in the junior golf tournament. Being surrounded by golfers increased her desire to excel. When she played with women, she said, she played like she had nothing to lose and she had fun with the results.

Manibusan will play in another NKGI tournament this month, and has been

saving up for a golf vacation to Europe sometime between August and October, she said.

"I'm definitely looking forward to it," she added.

Manibusan retained her amateur status as the \$100 she won at the tournament was for specialty golf lessons.
