The John F. Kennedy Lady Islanders capped off a perfect paddling season to the Guam Kayak and Canoe Federation High School Paddling Race Series 2023, following the final race Saturday at Matapang Beach.

The Notre Dame Royals girls paddling team also capped a season of second-place finishes from beginning to end. They were three seconds behind JFK's winning time in the first of two races and came 0.33 seconds away from tying the Islanders in the final heat of the season.

Third place came down to a single point, as Okkodo beat out the Academy of Our Lady of Guam 58 points to 27.

The Okkodo girls enjoyed their best weekend of the season. They finished the day with 16 points on two third-place finishes, while the Cougars earned 12 with seventh- and eighth-place finishes, respectively. It was enough to leapfrog to the podium for the girls division.

In the mixed division, the Islanders finished the sea-

son with two third-place finishes, but the 16 points they earned were enough to win the division comfortably with 83 points. The Notre Dame Royals mixed team finished second with 73 points, while Okkodo's squad took third with 56 points.

Of the nine races in the season series, the Islanders mixed team won the first five handily, but had just one first-place finish in the last four races.

The boys division was the most competitive of the last several years, with just eight points separating first place and third place.

The Bulldogs took the top spot taking the top spot, followed by JFK and in third, Father Dueñas Memorial School.

A third-place finish by the Bulldogs in the first heat kept them within striking distance of the field but then they took first in the final heat of the season, completing the dramatic finish.

The Islanders' first four batters all scored, and one was left stranded. When Tiyan came up to bat, their center fielder hit a double but the next three Titans went three up, three down.

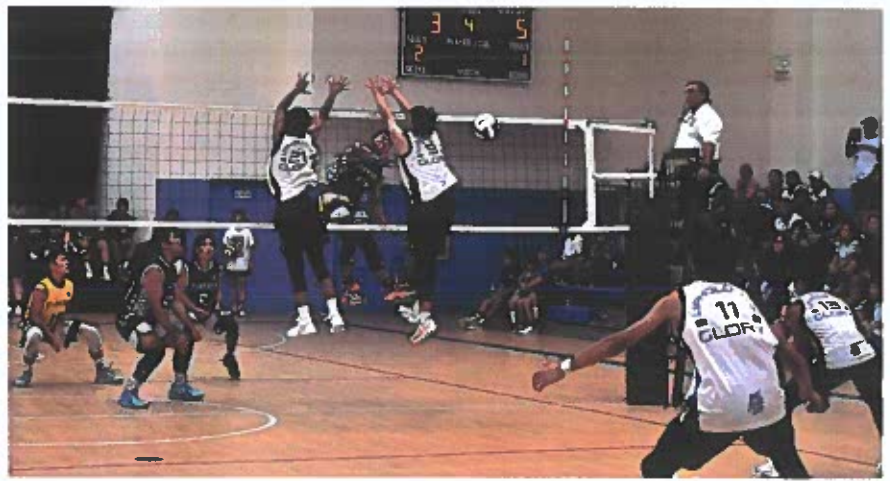
JFK added another run in the top of the second before the floodgates opened. The Titans scored 10 runs in the bottom of the second to take a commanding lead.
