The FSMB is currently considering a re-entry program if a physician has not been out-of-practice for 3 years or more. Dr. Alfred offered some examples as to why the length of time for being out-of-practiced should be re-considered. Dr. Berg stated that he would inform the work group, however, he stated that the FSMB is addressing the issue to determine a uniform policy to apply for all states and jurisdictions.</li> <li>He also stated that he will continue to work with TN on developing a Licensed Professional Impairment Program. The name of the program is also being considered. He stated that the Board should consider sending a communique to physicians that self-reporting would not have a detrimental impact on their record or be punitive and that the information would remain confidential.
