

MailHub delivers at Volley for a Cause

Fourteen teams dedicated their time during the Labor Day weekend to help raise funds for the annual Relay for Life. In the end, it was the MailHub Passports who overcame the Hatsa Volleyball Club for the victory to take home the trophy as the 2022 Volley for a Cause co-ed tournament.

The four-day tournament started on Friday, with the two top teams facing off Monday afternoon in a two-match thriller that had fans entertained from start to finish at the Dededo Sports Complex.
