No. 15 Kentucky 77, Tennessee 64: Immanuel Quickley scored 18 points as Kentucky (18-5, 8-2 SEC) beat host Tennessee (13-10, 5-5) to win for the sixth time in seven games and end its recent history of frustration in Knoxville. The Wildcats beat Tennessee in Knoxville for the first time in Rick Barnes' fiveseason tenure as the Volunteers'

No. 17 Iowa 96, Nebraska 72: Joe Wieskamp scored a career-high 30 points and Luka Garza added 22 to help host Iowa (17-7, 8-5 Big Ten) bounce back from its worst loss of the season with a win over Nebraska (17-7, 8-5 Big Ten).

Garza and Wieskamp came into the game averaging a combined 38 points per game, the sixth-best scoring duo in NCAA Division I play.

No. 22 Penn State 83, Minnesota 77: Lamar Stevens scored a career-high 33 points and host Penn State (18-5, 8-4 Big Ten) beat Minnesota (12-11, 6-7 Big Ten). Izaiah Brockington added 10 points for the Nittany Lions who won their sixth straight and snapped a five-game losing streak to Minnesota.

No. 21 Creighton 94, St. Johns 82: Marcus Zegarowski scored 23 points to lead five Creighton players in double figures and the 21stranked Bluejays beat St. John's 94-82 on Saturday.

No. 24 Colorado 81, Stanford 74: McKinley Wright IV scored 21 points, D'Shawn Schwartz added 20 and 24th-ranked Colorado overcame a cold start, a coach who lost his cool and a 16-point second-half deficit to beat short-handed Stanford 81-74 Saturday.

No. 1 Baylor 78, Oklahoma State 70: Cio Teague scored 24 points to lead five players in double figures for No. 1 Baylor, which stretched its winning streak to 20 games with a 78-70 victory over Oklahoma State on Saturday.

No. 7 Duke 98, North Carolina 96: Freshman Wendell Moore scored on a putback as time expired to help No. 7 Duke rally past North Carolina 98-96 in overtime in a wild renewal of the rivalry Saturday
