

"Everyone works to beat the Bombers and MVP; they set the standard for the league and feature some of the best players on the island," Palmer said in the release.

The PBS games will feature play-by-play commentary by Fred Peters, the coach at St. John's School, and Argie Flores, a former player in the league who will provide color, according to the release.

The league championship is set for Dec. 5.


