Additionally, she recommends consulting the Guam Board of Cosmetology. A. Wieelard suggested looking into OSHA Regulations as well. The Board thanks Mr. Root for bringing this discussion before the Board.

Pecina noted the conditions and safety of a facility is the direct responsibility of that facility. A. David noted, according to the Medical Practice Act, the healthcare institution has the duty to report any change in status of their physician employees. Additionally, the Medical Practice Act does not give the Board jurisdiction over healthcare organizations, just over physician licensees.
