		2. Geoffrey M. Fraiche Dr. Berg reiterated that the applicant had reported an incident that occurred while licensed in Florida. This incident was widely publicized in the media, and Dr. Berg believes the physician's explanation of the event in his letter to the Board was dismissive. He recommends that the Board request court documents related to the incident. Dr. Nyame inquired whether a court or criminal conviction would automatically nullify the application. Dr. Berg responded by citing existing language, which states that licenses are not granted to individuals convicted of crimes of moral turpitude. Dr. Nyame expressed that he does not believe requesting court documents would change his stance. Instead, he feels it is important for the physician to acknowledge the wrongdoing. Dr. Berg agreed with this sentiment. Dr. Cruz reiterated his support for requesting the court documents and suggested contacting the Florida Board to understand why they did not pursue disciplinary action. Dr. Berg pointed out that the physician's Florida license may have expired before the Board could take action, and as a result, the Board may have lacked jurisdiction. Dr. Wielaard noted that while the physician's side of the story has been well documented, it is crucial to gather all facts surrounding the incident. He also emphasized that the case does not pertain to the physician's clinical practice. Dr. Wielaard recommended obtaining letters of reference from the physician's colleagues in Saipan.
