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VII	Treasurer's Report	<ol> <li>E. Lisa provided a financial overview of the financial report. Carryover from FY 2021 of approximately \$20K is still available for GBNE for FY 2022. For FY 2022, as of Feb 2022. No expenditures to date. The Chair suggested that it would be helpful for the GBNE to have more visibility on the budget line items for Contractual and Miscellaneous in future reports. E. Dames stated that the GBME and GBNE generate the majority of the revenue and that there are shared costs with the other HPLO Boards and there are shared costs with other HPLO Board's.</li> <li>In reference to a discussion pertaining to Stipends for Exam Proctors:         <ol> <li>a. The Chair inquired if Miscellaneous funds could be used to pay stipends to proctors as discussed in the previous GBNE meetings. E. Dames stated that, in discussion with the Acting, HPLO Administrator, B. Sablan, more research is needed in the procurement and administrative requirements to pay stipends to proctors (e.g., training and certification of proctors, requirement</li> </ol> </li> </ol>			Noted Tabled
		for business licenses, establishment of vendors, etc.). She further stated that the budget will need to be assessed to determine if there would be sufficient funding since stipends were not included in the budget, In the meantime, E. Dames suggested considering using volunteers to administer until requirements could be fully determined and procedures established.  b. The Chair stated that since revenues far exceed expenses to date and since it is difficult to get volunteers, the GBNE needs to address more efficient ways to get CNAs tested and certified as expeditiously as possible. Therefore, suggested that since Registered Nurses (RN) have business licenses, they could be considered initially since they already oversee aides, while the procurement and administration requirements are explored.  c. R. Carman, HPLO stated that there are usually 10-20 examinees and testing is usually completed by noon. Initially, testing was delayed as a result of the pandemic and securing a testing venue; however, the venue is no longer a problem. Recent delays have been caused primarily due to timely receipt of testing materials.  d. Regarding the use of volunteers:  i. The Chair expressed concern of seeking volunteers since nurses are experiencing burn-out			
		<ul> <li>due to the pandemic.</li> <li>ii. B. Manzana indicated that LPNs were able to volunteer in the past and suggested a volunteer roster be created in the meantime. The Chair stated that LPNs could be considered provided their scope of work allows for them to check-off skills.</li> <li>iii. Board members traditionally assisted in past, however, the GBNE is currently faced with other agenda priorities.</li> <li>e. The Chair proposed the GBNE vote on paying stipends for proctors. E. Dames stated that she recalls in a prior GBNE meeting A. Varghese was doing some research in this and recommended to table a decision on this matter until the next meeting. P. Manzon also suggested that more time to work-out details, e.g., number of proctors required, administrative forms, etc. G. Woodard commented that approximately four (4) hours of proctoring equates to \$25/hour, so a lot of effort could be expended on this matter with little benefit. <i>Motioned to table the stipend proposal until the next meeting: E.
