

mission board he "took the report that was submitted and made my changes on there," to recommend a transfer of application rights from husband to wife. He said he is the direct supervisor of the land agents and meets with them to discuss their reports. In most cases, he agrees with their recommendations, he stated.

## Senator's concerns

Because the document was changed, "forgery may be at play," Sen. Joanne Brown said in a letter to Gov. Leon Guerrero, who appointed Hattig to manage the Land Trust. Brown stated news reports about the incident "raise serious questions about the integrity of the administrative director and the commission's current practices."

The board met March 18 and after coming out of executive session, the commission's Chairman John Reyes Jr. said they met with Hattig and "definitely have addressed these issues at hand."

"The clarity, the cooperation and the transparency is needed and needs to be realized," Reyes added.

No action was taken at the March 18 meeting and it was recessed until March 25, but that meeting was postponed due to lack of quorum.

## Report not shared

The Vigilance Committee has asked Reyes for a copy of his report on Hattig, but Reyes denied the request because it relates to personnel matters exempted from disclosures and isn't classified as a public record.

"Stonewalling does nothing to enhance the respectability of the (Land Trust)," said Lee Webber, president of the Vigilance Committee.

He said not providing the report leaves both land agents and the general public unsure and potentially confused, still questioning Hattig's conduct and the integrity of the Land Trust process.

# Dentists see spike in cracked teeth amid pandemic

When stress builds for Terri Hart-Ellis, she subconsciously clenches her teeth like an angry cartoon character.

"My jaws tighten. I bite down really hard and my eyebrows flare," Hart-Ellis said. "Most of the time, I'm not even aware of it."

But all that biting and clenching has taken a toll: She chipped a molar in May, and last month pulled off a crown.

Hart-Ellis, 53, is hardly alone: During this year of pandemic stress, the American Dental Association says that dental health is a casualty. An ADA survey found more than 70% of dentists report an increase of patients with teeth grinding and clenching problems — conditions often associated with stress.

"The number of chipped and cracked teeth really started to pick up as people's stress level picked up," said Dr. Paul Levine, of Levine Dental Associates in Milwaukee.

Much of the stress and

worry in Hart-Ellis' life stemmed from all the unknowns of the past year: Businesses shutting down, kids being sent home from school, stay-at-home orders, COVID-19 cases by the

thousands. Deaths.

"It was overwhelming. Like most people, I was scared," she said.

Her oldest daughter, Caetrona, 21, a senior at the University of Wisconsin-

Oshkosh, had to move back home when the campus shut down. Her youngest daughter, Addison, 17, has a rare disease called Rubinstein Taybi syndrome, and has been learning remotely at home, a task made more difficult because she's non-verbal.

"My full-time job is working with Addison, so it's been a big change for all of us," she said. "We're all stressed."

As a mom who cleans and sanitizes everything, Hart-Ellis said she often feels like she is the last line of defense.

Both her dental problems can be linked to teeth clenching brought on by the stress of the pandemic. Before the pandemic, Hart-Ellis said she had very few dental problems.

"I took pride in my smile and teeth," she said. "I make sure I brush and floss, so I wouldn't have any problems."

One day in April, while disinfecting the kitchen, she put a Hershey miniature in her mouth. When she bit down, she heard a crunch.

"It was really hard, and I opened my mouth and there it was: a piece of my tooth chipped off," she said. "I couldn't believe it because I take good care of my teeth."

The chipped molar wasn't painful, so because of the pandemic, Hart-Ellis decided to postpone a dentist visit.

Then, while flossing this month, Hart-Ellis popped her crown off.

Out of dentists surveyed, 71% reported an increase in

teeth grinding and clenching; 63% reported an increase in chipped and cracked teeth, and 62% reported an increase in temporomandibular joint disorder, according to the American Dental Association Health Policy Institute study released March 2.

On Sept. 21, fewer than 60% of dentists surveyed reported increases in the same categories.

Most patients are unaware they have a problem until someone points it out, Levine said.

"If you're sleeping, you may not notice that you're grinding your teeth, but your spouse or partner may notice," he said. "It's the same thing with clenching your teeth."

Clenching and grinding teeth are different things.

Clenching is simply forceful, silent pressure on the jaws and teeth between the top and lower rows. Grinding occurs when the lower jaw is tightened and moves sideways against the upper jaw, Levine said.

Grinding teeth often leave distinct patterns of wear that can be seen only during a dental exam.

Sometimes, dentists struggle to persuade patients they have a problem.

"We can tell them that they have a problem and tell them they need a mouth guard, and they say they don't have a problem, but we end up seeing them back in a month or so and the problem has gotten a lot worse and more expensive,"
