four times a week.

The John F. Kennedy High Islanders, which swept all three varsity divisions last season, are back with some returnees and enough paddlers to fill all roster spots. They are coached by Afshin Amoui.

The Notre Dame High Royals also have good numbers to fill the boats in the varsity boys, varsity girls, varsity mixed and junior varsity divisions. They are coached by Joe Nowell.

Okkodo High had only 19 paddlers as of Jan. 25, said coach Mel

Treitas. A team can get by with fewer paddlers, if part of their boys and girls varsity teams also paddle for the mixed team.

A team can get by with five of the usual six paddlers, such as when the Bulldogs took third place last season in the boys varsity division.

No returnees

The Simon Sanchez High Sharks have been a contender for years. They won't be this year, said long-time coach Ron Ruiz.

"No returnees for the boys. Zero," he said. "And just one for the girls. Fortunately, she's a four-year starter and steerswoman,"

he said, referring to senior Abby Ibanez.

The races will consist of lengths between 500 meters and 1,200 meters. The division champions will be determined by accumulated points.

COVID-19 precautions will be in place for the season. A roster maximum has been established. On race days, teams must stay within their team tents.
