VIII	Old Business	A. Complaint: GBSW-CO-2024-001 A. Lape addressed the complaint GBSW-CO-2024-001, referencing discussions from the previous month. She noted that the complaint was submitted anonymously, leaving no individual to follow up with. A. Lape explained that according to their draft rules and regulations and the practice act, licensees have the right to respond to or speak with the person filing a complaint. As a result, the board's policies do not allow for the consideration of anonymous complaints. After reviewing the situation, A. Lape suggested that either D. Calvo or J. Baleto take the lead in reviewing the complaint and possibly contact the licensee's employer to inform them of the complaint. The employer could then choose to investigate further or take no action, as deemed appropriate. Since the board cannot engage with the anonymous complainant, A.
