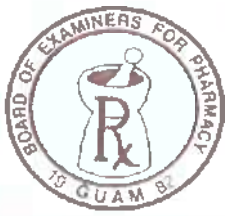

Hamlin back in Buffalo

ORCHARD PARK, N.Y. (AP) — Bills safety Damar Hamlin said he returned to Buffalo on Monday "with a lot of love on my heart" to continue his recovery in a hospital there, a week after going into cardiac arrest and having to be resuscitated on the field during a game in Cincinnati.

Hamlin was dis-

charged from the University of Cincinnati Medical Center in the morning and flown to western New York. He was listed in stable condition at Buffalo General Medical Center/Gates Vascular Institute.

"I can confirm that he is doing well. And this is the beginning of the next stage of his recovery," said Dr. William Knight, one of his doctors in Cincinnati.

Doctors said Hamlin has been walking since having a breathing tube removed on

Friday, eating regular food and undergoing therapy. They said he was on a normal or even accelerated trajectory in his recovery from cardiac arrest, which is considered a life-threatening event, and that normal recovery can be measured from weeks to months.

"We continue to be ecstatic about his recovery," Dr. Timothy Pritts said.

Hamlin's return comes a day after he cheered on the Bills from his hospital bed during their regular season ending 35-23 win over the New England Patriots. The game proved to be a cathartic outpouring of support for the Bills

and Hamlin.

"Truly amazing"

"Headed home to Buffalo today with a lot of love on my heart," Hamlin said in a tweet. "Watching the world come together around me on Sunday was truly an amazing feeling."

Hamlin was so excited watching teammate Nyheim Hines return the opening kickoff 96 yards for a touchdown that "he jumped up and down, got out of his chair, set every alarm off in the ICU in the process," Pritts said with a laugh. "But he was fine. It was just appropriate reaction to very exciting play."

Si Woo Kim rallies, wins Sony Open

HONOLULU Open to life Sunday (AP) — Si Woo Kim with a birdie-birdie brought a sleepy Sony finish that gave him

a 6-under 64 and a one-shot victory over Hayden Buckley. Buckley had a two-shot lead at the start of the day and was among nine players from the leading 16 going into the final round who had never won.

Kim, who started the day three shots behind, finally caught up late in the round. But then Buckley holed a 15-foot birdie putt on the 16th hole to regain the lead, and Kim was in the group ahead of him in the rough just over the green at the par-3 17th.

Kim heard the cheer from Buckley's birdie, and then produced a moment of his own. He chipped in from just under 30 feet to tie Buckley again.

"Right before that, I heard the noise," Kim said. "It was kind of a tough lie. I had to hit it aggressive — nothing to lose. I hit it aggressive, it goes in. It was exciting."

On the par-5 closing hole, Kim's shot from 236 yards in a fairway bunker tumbled across the dry, fast turf of Waialae Country Club and onto the green. He took two putts from 40 feet for birdie, and then had to wait.
