VI	<p><b>A. Rules and Regulations.</b> A meeting with B. Sablan-HPLO is planned to help align the schedule, ensuring everything is properly matched and ready to proceed with a review of the rules and regulations.</p> <p><b>B. Complaints</b></p> <p><b>1. GBBC-CO-2024-0001 – Date Received: 01/16/2024.</b></p> <p>a. The Board previously deferred suggestions or voting due to R. Santos' absence. This complaint involved testimony from Mr. Blas, who provided details about the unlicensed work at the salon. The person admitted to working at the salon without proper licensing. Additionally, it was noted that S. Sapp allowed Mr. Blas to work without an apprentice permit. The Board emphasized that establishments are responsible for ensuring that their employees have the necessary licenses or permit.</p> <p>b. The Board concluded that the establishment owners are responsible for ensuring proper licensing of their employees and discussed options for penalties, to include statutory fines, revoking the salon's license, the authority to supervise apprentices in the future, etc. The consensus was that the establishment owner should be held accountable for licensing violations that occurred under his supervision.</p> <p>c. Z. Pecina provided an overview of the disciplinary process, outlining steps including counseling, issuing a letter of warning, a letter of reprimand, or taking adverse action (e.g., revoking, suspending the license, or imposing a penalty, either individually or in combination) based on the investigator's findings. The Board discussed re-assigning the investigator role for the complaint.</p> <p>d. The Board assigned an investigator, who will consult with the Office of the Attorney General. A recommendation will be presented at the next meeting.</p> <p><b>2. GBBC-CO-2024-0002 – Date Received: 04/22/2024.</b></p> <p>The Board discussed the complaint concerning a nail salon and a technician using prohibited instruments resulting in blood spillage. The Board assigned R. Santos to the case and will inform the DPHSS DEH due to sanitation violations, as well as the salon owner to ascertain the technician's identity. Progress updates are expected for the next meeting to ensure the investigation proceeds effectively.</p>	GBBC	0915	On-going

	<p>which is a mandatory for accreditation application submission. He expressed concern about the school's enrollment, mostly consisting of part-time students, and emphasized the need to increase enrollment to sustain the school financially. In addition, D. Gurwell provided an overview of the business relationship with Rinaldo in Stay Fresh Academy, where either partner can represent the company at events such as the upcoming ISS workshop in Las Vegas. This arrangement allows flexibility in who attends mandatory events on behalf of the academy.</p> <p>The dates of the upcoming ISS (Individual Self-Study) workshop dates are confirmed for 14-16 September 2024 and Stay Fresh Academy is in the process of retrieving the extension letter for their establishment license.</p> <p>D. Gurwell expressed the financial and accreditation process challenges and frustration over the high expenses, which make accreditation practically cost-prohibitive.</p> <p>In response to M. Tong's request, D. Gurwell stated that pre-payment for registration to ensure compliance with the workshop requirement prior to submitting their application for accreditation. The Chair confirmed that the current expiration date of their establishment license on July 8; therefore, requested D. Gurwell to provide registration confirmation for the ISS by September to keep their records updated. D. Gurwell expressed his gratitude for GBBC's understanding. The Chair requested the GBBC kept apprised of the establishment's efforts to maintain its license.</p>			
<p><b>F. Mariacy Beauty Academy</b></p>	<p>Mariacy Beauty Academy addressed its need to attend the ISS workshop and their current status regarding accreditation, and the need to reapply for candidate status and are hopeful that their existing certificates will expedite their process into initial accreditation without having to go through pre-candidate status. Mariacy Beauty Academy expressed its goal of completing the initial accreditation visit before the end of the year.</p> <p>The Chair confirmed that Mariacy Beauty Academy is approved based on their certificates not being expired, noting the pre-candidate status might be waived, outlining the steps involved, including applying for a consultation visit and the initial accreditation process, culminating in a school visit to determine accreditation.</p>			<p>Unanimously Tabled; Mariacy Beauty Academy to Provide Proof of ISS Registration</p>
