"On the first couple of throws, I was trying to drive my hips forward to have more power, but it didn't work for me. On my last throw, I just tried to power it through with my arms," he said. "I honestly didn't think it was far enough."

His final throw wasn't as far as he had tossed on Guam with a heavier javelin and it was also only about half of the gold-medal throw of 61 meters. But it inspired him to give the iavelin more attention when he enters his junior year at John F. Kennedy High in the fall.

"I'd like to get the high school record before I graduate," he said. The record of 46 meters was set two track seasons ago by Travon Jacobs.

Valdez also finished the 1,500-meter run Tuesday, coming in ninth out of nine runners. He was scheduled to run the 800 meters Wednesday.

He then said that he's not ruling out another competition. "Yes, you will definitely see me compete elsewhere later this year," Muñoz said.


