The Islanders were a distant fourth place in the league at 4-3, behind Guam High, Academy, and Tiyan which had identical 6-1 records. But not only did the Green Machine come to play, they played to win.

The Islanders' first four batters all scored, and one was left stranded. When Tiyan came up to bat, their center fielder hit a double but the next three Titans went three up, three down.

JFK added another run in the top of the second before the floodgates opened. The Titans scored 10 runs in the bottom of the second to take a commanding lead.

JFK chipped away, getting two runs in the fourth, three runs in the fifth and finally tied the game at 13-13 in the top of the seventh.

The Titans' first two batters got on base, and Isabella Acosta hit a sacrifice bunt to advance the runners before Kamea Leon Guerrero's heroics.

"JFK played tough. They came to play tonight and they were tough," said Acosta. "It was a really good game, and not an easy one."
