celebrated quickly went back to work.

"We will be searching for a new women's national team head coach while we work to rebuild ahead of the upcoming competitions."

Ogura was hired in mid-December. Her signing took many months to formally finalize, said GFA President Tino San Gil, according to Pacific Daily News files.

Ogura had said her immediate priorities would be to assess the team, study film and prepare the Masakåda for the East Asian Football Federation E-1 Football Championship 2022 Round 1. That round — and Guam's chance for competition - was canceled in April.

In January, Ogura held open house trials at the GFA National Training Center and followed that with a southern edition of the program in mid-April.

Ogura got to see Guam's national team in action in February, when the GFA hosted teams from the Northern Mariana Islands.

In training matches, the Guam women's team settled for a scoreless draw in the first match and in the second match lost 1-0.
