INTERNATIONAL LICENSING INQUIRY. A. Mariano stated that no local rules and regulations allow for the licensing of an international entity. S. Watson stated that this inquiry was sent to all states, and a state survey was done. The shipment would be from manufacturer to Cardinal to Cardinal. They are trying to find the requirements for each state and territory as Guam does not have rules and regulations on international licensing, but some states do. J. Caruso stated that everything on Guam is from the United States, and all FDA and DEA requirements and approvals are necessary. S. Watson will take this answer back to her team.	individual orders. There are requirements to maintain the controlled substance monitoring program. Every controlled substance is assigned thresholds. When a threshold is hit, it is flagged in the system as suspicious, the order is cancelled, and a suspicious order report is submitted to the appropriate board of pharmacy as well as to the DEA. The report does not mean a diversion is taking place, it is just being flagged as suspicious because a threshold is met. If the pharmacy places an order once it resets and is below the threshold, the order will go through. J. Caruso stated that when he made the order, there was a typing error. S. Watson stated that there is a process for a threshold change request via cardinalhealth.com/csmp with an average processing time of 9-10 business days. J.
