Opening the Dededo pool will probably be done before re-opening the Hagåtña Pool, according to the task force's latest report. The Dededo facility must now comply with public health requirements that include baby changing stations, bathroom lights and pre-rinse showers, among others.

The Hagåtña pool is undergoing an assessment by Amorient, which received the go ahead to start on Aug. 24. The office structure that was destroyed in a fire is being removed, and the Department of Public Works could issue a new completion date for the assess-

ment.

Goal No. 3 has been accomplished, said Flores, who used his background as a retired Air Force colonel to help facilitate the GSF's request to hold a club meet at Naval Base Guam. The GSF successfully held a meet Sept. 24, open to Guam's club teams.

"It was the first swim meet in over 30 months," said Flores.

Half of the grant funding sought has already been disbursed and spent, said Flores. The GSF was awarded a \$63,000 grant through the governor's Education Assistance and Youth Empowerment Grant Program. The GSF used \$31,750 on swimmer education and training, including books and equipment.

Lastly, the Micronesian Aquatics

Center is still in the dream phase, though it does have the governor's support, said Flores. It would be a huge facility endorsed by FINA, the world's governing body for swimming, and it would rival, or even exceed some of the regional facilities that Guam's international competitors have been swimming in for years.

Such a facility would be home to swimmers, water polo players and potentially competition divers.

### Public opinion encouraged

Flores added that Guam should not build a new facility until it proves it can maintain existing facilities. The Hagåtña Pool still has years of life left, said Flores, and members of the public should let their feelings on the pool be

known.

When Flores started swimming in 1978, he said there was never an issue of if the pool was open because it was always open. Flores graduated from Father Dueñas Memorial School in 1987 and he continued to swim through college, and was the first Chamoru swimmer to compete in NCAA Division 1 during his time at the Air Force Academy. Flores also represented Guam at the 1992 Olympics in Barcelona, and continued to swim competitively in the master's division for many years afterward. He retired from the Air Force as a colonel, and is now a high school ROTC instructor.

## Mickelson wants name removed from lawsuit

Phil Mickelson, the driving force among PGA Tour players in the rival LIV Golf series, and three other players asked a federal judge Tuesday to remove their names from the antitrust lawsuit against the PGA Tour.

Talor Gooch, Hudson Swafford and Ian Poulter filed separately to have their names removed. That leaves only three players — Bryson DeChambeau, Peter Uihlein and Matt Jones — and Saudi-funded LIV Golf as plaintiffs in the lawsuit filed in early August.

The trial is not scheduled to begin until January 2024.

Mickelson's decision was not a surprise. He had said two weeks ago to SI.com that he no longer needed to be involved in the lawsuit now that LIV Golf has joined as a plaintiff.

"The only reason for me to stay in is damages, which I don't really want or need anything," Mickelson said. "I do think it's important that the players have the right to play when and where they want, when and where they qualify for. And now that LIV is a part of it,

that will be accomplished if and when they win."

LIV Golf already suffered one setback in court when U.S. District Judge Beth Labson Freeman denied a temporary restraining order that sought to allow LIV Golf players to compete in the PGA Tour's lucrative postseason.

Mickelson has been one of the chief recruiters for LIV Golf and its leader,

Greg Norman.

In an interview with Alan Shipnuck for his biography on Mickelson, the six-time major champion said he recruited three other "top players" for LIV Golf and that they paid attorneys to write the operating agreement for the proposed league.

Mickelson was among the last players announced when LIV Golf and its \$25

million purses began in early June. There now have been five events, with the next two scheduled in October in Thailand and Saudi Arabia.

LIV Golf has 12 of the top 50 in the world ranking.

in the 450 class and Varize finished 10th in the 250 class. Lipanovich came in 22nd in the 450 cc KTM, which was able to have Team Guam place 14th in the qualifiers and able to compete the main event the next day, according to the release.

### Main event

The final competition filled three motos with mud due to rain. Bloss and Varize returned to compete where Bloss found himself at sixth place in three laps. However, several crashes and a blown engine knocked him down to 16th place, according to the release. Bloss ended up placing 34th in moto 1.

Varize fell to a disadvantage with competing with bikes meant for the 450 class on a bike meant for the 250 class. Varize finished at 29th place, accord-

ing to the release.

Moto 2 had Lipanovich and Varize compete in the Open class. Lipanovich started off strong. He then suffered a smoked engine which he attended to. Lipanovich ended up at 32nd place. Varize improved by placing 20th, according to the release.

Moto 3, also known as the final moto, had Bloss and Lipanovich compete in the Open and MXGP classes. Bloss pushed through the pouring rain with a missing engine, according to the release. He was able to have his bike attended to,

but found they had to forfeit the race to finish 35th.

Lipanovich stayed in the race with a backup bike. He made the switch days prior, according to the release. He pushed through while staying cautious. Though this slowed him down, Lipanovich finished the race in 32nd place and saved his bike. Team Guam overall placed 17th place, according to the release.

Despite the placements, Team Guam was happy to be included in the main event, according to the release.
