# Rams build star-studded NFL team

LOS ANGELES (AP) -No team in the NFL was built like the Los Angeles Rams because nobody else would dare.

No organization shares the Rams' unorthodox values or their depth of faith in themselves. Nobody else manages its high draft picks like Los Angeles does. and no team has navigated the minefield of mid-career veteran acquisition with the Rams' success.

No front office executive has Rains general manager Les Snead's audacity. No coach has shown Sean Mc-Vay's ability to blend newly arrived stars into a harmonious team concept year after year.

The Rams know who they are, and they're not changing until the wheels fall off.

Maybe that's not for everybody, and maybe that's not sustainable. Rams chief operating officer Keyin Demoil said. "Maybe it doesn't work long-term. even though we seem to figure it out every year. But it's working right now."



A team that hasn't made a first-round draft pick since 2016 and probably won't make another until at least 2024 is in the Super Bowl for the second time in four years during a half-decade with five winning seasons and three NFC West titles under McVay. Los Angeles is set up to contend again next season, even if every big-name addition walks away to cash in the rehabilitated value created by stopping off in Hollywood. Jalen Ramsey Matthew

Stafford, Odell Beckham Jr., Von Miller, Leonard Floyd and Andrew Whitworth will play extensively for the Rams against Cincinnati in Super Bowl 56. They all started their careers elsewhere before joining the Rams, who gladly paid high prices to get thein.

Many other expensive veterans already have come and gone. # Frank 'Crank' Camacho fights May 14

Professional mixed martial arts fighter Frank The Crank' Camacho now has both an opponent and a date to look forward to.

Camacho will fight Manuci Torres on May 14. It will be his first fight in about two years, and he can't wait:

I was supposed to fight in 2020, tested positive for COVID, fight got scratched, such a bummer. And then last year June, supposed to fight again, the week of, got into a car wreck on the freeway in the states and was going through rehab the rest of the year," he said. I finally got cleared in October of last year and I've been training since. And finally I'm so stoked to get on a card, and I have a dancing partner."

Camacho at the time said he was lucky to get away with just an injured neck and a couple of herniated



discs on his spine. He had to call his manager, who informed the UFC about the accident. Crank was primed for UFC 263, where he was scheduled to fight Matt Frevola June 12, 2021. in Glendale, Arizona.

Camacho is 22-9-0 and

is 32 years old. Torres is 26, and holds a 12-20 professional record. The two will fight at 155 pounds. Torres is riding a 3-win streak, according to tapology.com. He is known as El Loco and is the No. 6 ranked prolightweight in Mexico

Camacho said hes got a different mindset nowadays and while still hungry to win, considers himself a veteran in the pro-MMA game. He admits needing a little bit of time to stretch out before a workout and that his time away from the ring taught him a few things

Gratitude. You know when you take something away that I love to do, which is fight, it kinda puts a lot of things into perspective. he said. The cool thing is that for the two years I didn't have a fight. I was preparing for three fights. I still wake up every day and want to better myself. I still enjoy the process, and that's what I'm really stoked about."

Camacho said he won't change much about his routine, though he admits he might have more intensity now that he can circle a calendar date.

"At the end of the day, it's income for me, so that was two years of no income," he said. "That gets kinda hard but, we worked our way around it, now we got a date and I'm super excited to show the world what I've been working on?
