

Step by Step Enrollment:

- 1. Pick up the "EMSC SNIP PROJECT" packet from the Department of Public Health and Social Services, Office of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) at Terlaje Building Suite 213 Hernan Cortez Avenue, Hagatna Guam 96910
- 2. Complete and sign the medical history forms.
- 3. Have the information verified by your child's physician and return it to the Office of EMS.
- 4. The Medical information provided will be transferred to a personalized EMSC SNIP Medical History Card.
- 5. The EMSC SNIP Medical History card may be picked up at our office.
- 6. Keep the card readily available at home and take it with your child whenever away from home

What is SNIP?

Special Needs Identification Program

A pre-hospital notification system for EMT's, Nurses, and Physicians designed to improve pre-hospital emergency medical care for children with special health care needs and other pre-existing conditions.

Purpose:

To ensure the emergency medical technicians, the school nurses, the public health nurses and physicians, and the emergency room nurses and physicians, are aware of your child's special health needs in order to provide special medical care and attention to your child during lifesaving emergencies.

What happens to my child during an emergency as a SNIP?

CALL 911, PROVIDE YOUR CHILD'S NAME



EMT OR NURSE KNOWS YOUR CHILD AND PROVIDES LIFE SAVING CARE TO YOUR CHILD



EMERGENCY ROOM PHYSICIAN AND NURSE TAKE GOOD CARE OF YOUR CHILD



CHILD RECEIVES EXCELLENT MEDICAL CARE.

In an Emergency:

- 1. CALL 911. EMS PROVIDERS WILL BE DISPATCHED TO YOUR LOCATION
- 2. HAVE THE EMSC SNIP MEDICAL HISTORY CARD READY AND IMMEDIATELY PROVIDE IT TO THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN (EMT) WHEN THEY ARRIVE
- 3. THE EMTS WILL GATHER ALL THE INFORMATION NEEDED FROM THE CARD TO IMMEDIATELY TRANSPORT YOUR CHILD TO THE EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT.
